A number of bands were turned away in the past when both the Band Review and the Field Show Tournament reached capacity, so it important I know if you plan to attend as early as possible. - You are interested in attending the <u>Band Review</u>, <u>Field Show Tournament</u>, or <u>both</u>.
- What competition march selection you have selected for the Band Review.
- In what SCSBOA Field Division you anticipate entering (1A, 2A, 3A, 4A, 5A, or 6A).

SAT Testing – For those bands that will be attending the AM Field Show Tournament (1A/2A/3A Divisions), please be aware November 2 is a SAT testing day. If seniors and juniors are a significant portion of your band, the testing may interfere with your performance. In previous years band directors have stressed students to take the exam in nearby communities so they have time to commute to the event in time to participate.

The Chino Invitational features the following:

- Hosted by the award-winning, seventime 6A Division Champions Chino HS 77Th Cavalry Band and Pageantry
- AM Field Tournament/Afternoon Band Review (Parade)/PM Field Tournament
- Bands may compete in either the Band Review or the Field Tournament or Both
- Buses are parked once at arrival and may remain parked there until departure.
- Short band review route (1.1 miles)
- Full Band Review Judging Panel

- Special "Show-Off" Area at the end of the parade route to demonstrate your competitive performance or something completely different to preceding bands
- Perpetual Trophy presented to the Band Review Band Sweepstakes winner
- Full Field Tournament Judging Panel, including Percussion
- Combined awards presented to all bands participating in both the Band Review and the PM Field Show Tournament.

Have a great remainder of the summer and I hope to see you on November 2.
